Treasure Laws & Event Funding

- Event Funding
 - Event funding will be granted to groups seeking to host an event of interest or value to graduate students, as determined by the individual organizations. These may include but are not limited to invited talks, workshops, academic conferences, or other organizational event.
 - Allocation will be made based on the estimated number of anticipated attendees.
 - For recurring events, estimates of attendance will be compared for congruence with previous years' attendance as stated on completed post-event Conference Evaluation Forms.
 - Events will be funded at a rate of \$10/attendee, from a minimum of \$50 up to a maximum of \$3000.
 - All events will be subject to a discrepancy review. Total actual attendance must not be less by 15% of the original total estimated attendance or 25 people, whichever is greater. The penalty for significant underestimates will be equal to the total difference between the estimated funding amount and the amount generated from the actual attendance level.
- All events must comply with all regulations of the SAFC and the applicable regulations of Student Organizations.
